

Hi, I'm Harry, I spend most of my time making electroacoustic sounds/music. So, much like the mathematician who can't help but bake Rubik's cube cakes, my visual ideas are often organised by musical (or sonic) principles. My audiovisual work has mainly focused on 2D/3D animation, but also includes structural film experiments and installations, all with an emphasis on the close interaction between sound and image. www.harry-burgess.com

Strands is a process piece—an additive build of materials and expansion of physical space resembles a drawn-out visual crescendo, building to a climax that never comes. I wanted the work to reflect this specific musical structure, while being totally open to new and unexpected sonic reimaginings. This collaborative aspect of the work was at the forefront of my mind while making the work—as a composer, my thought continually strayed: how would these visual ideas be translated to sound? Thanks to some wonderful musicians, the translation isn't up to me. I'm very excited to hear the sounds/noises they come up with!
